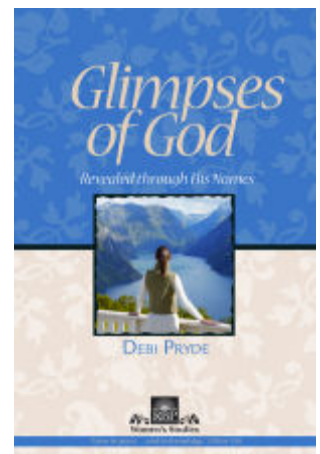
How Many Names Do You Have?
