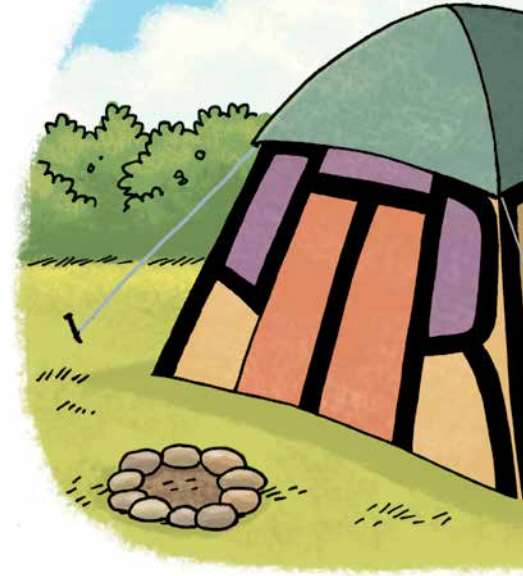

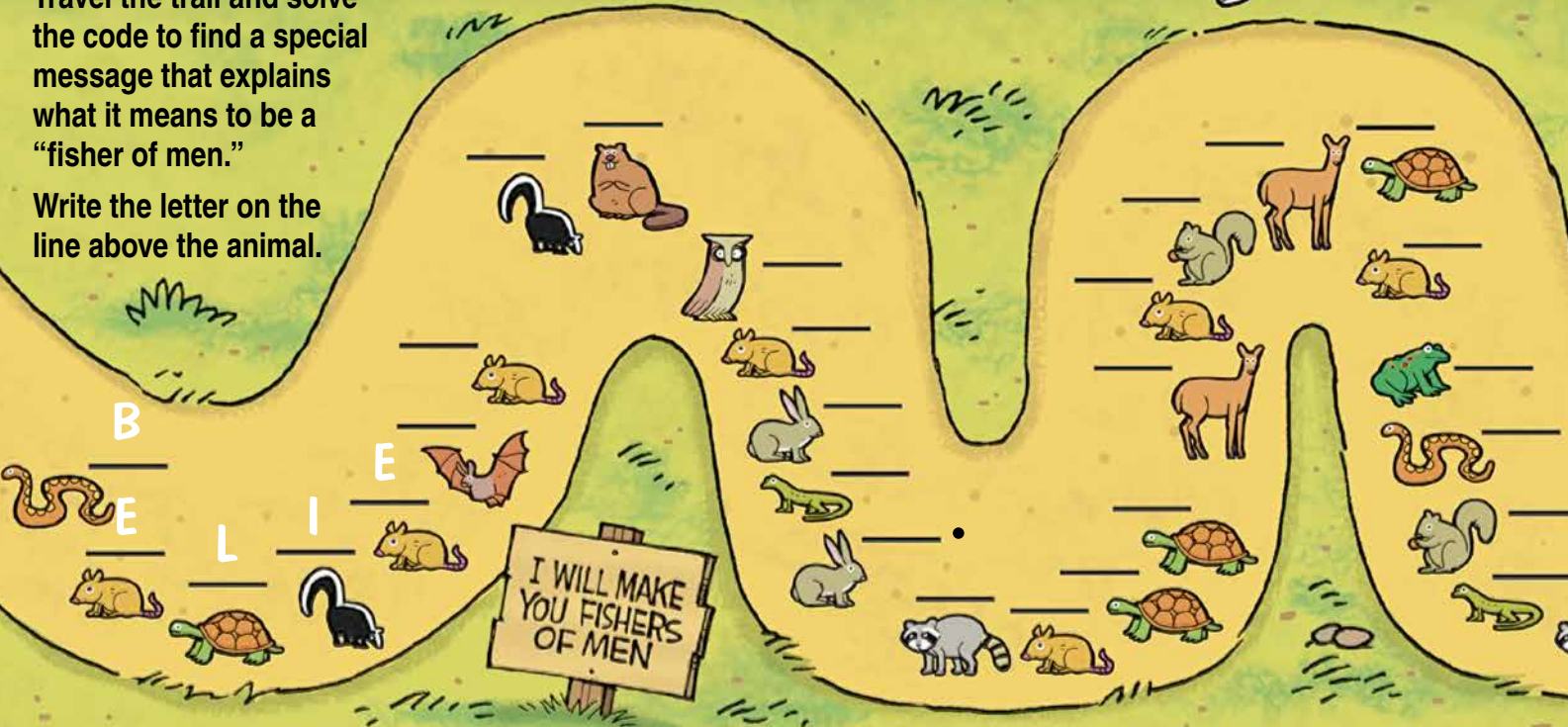

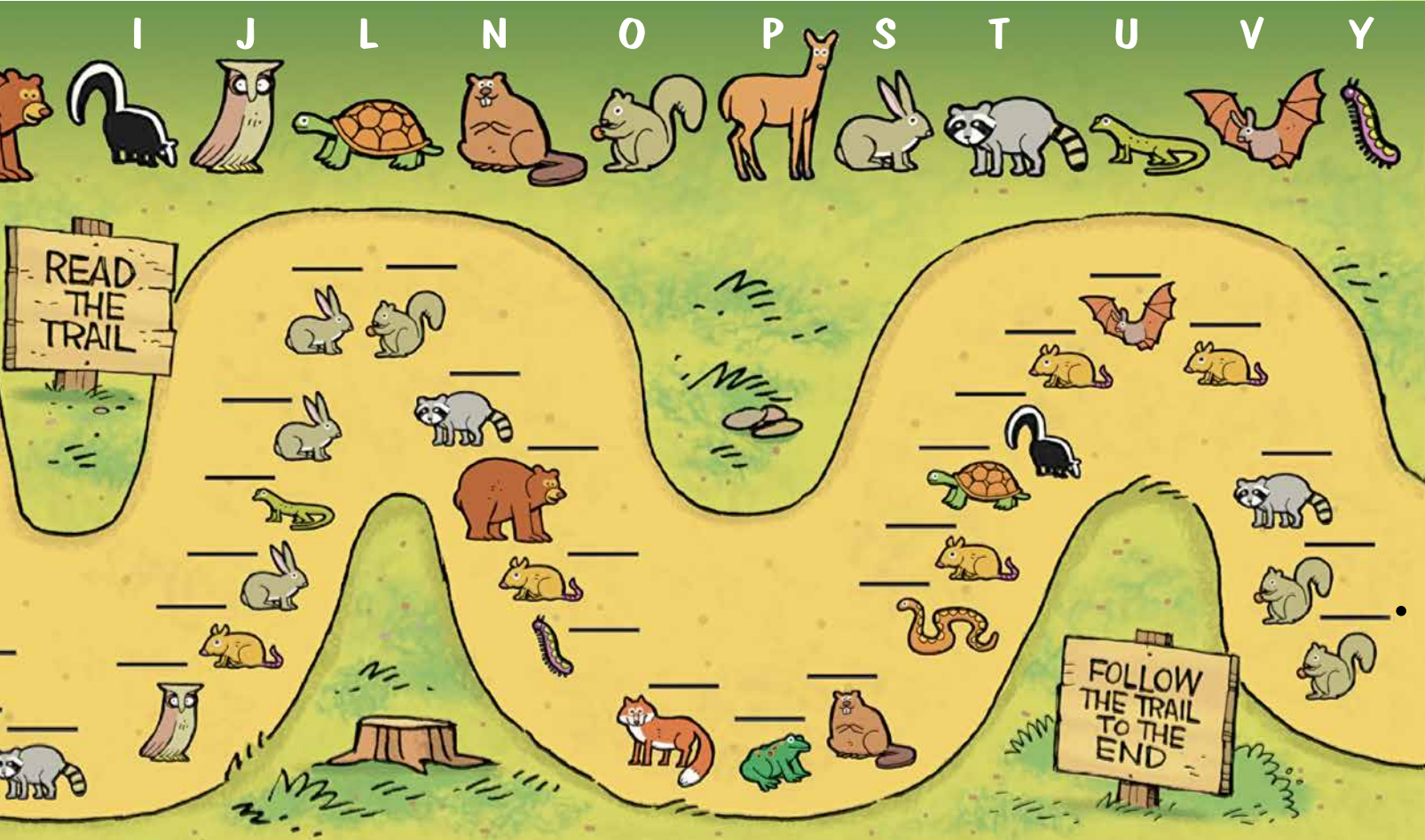
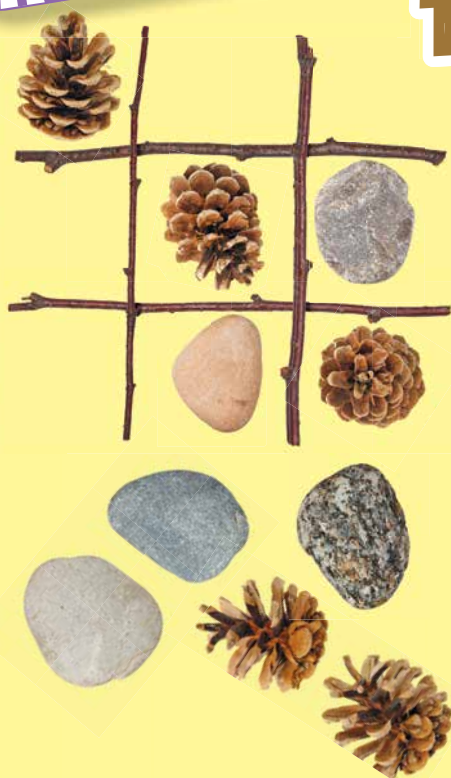
NATURE TIC-TAC-TOE

You will need:

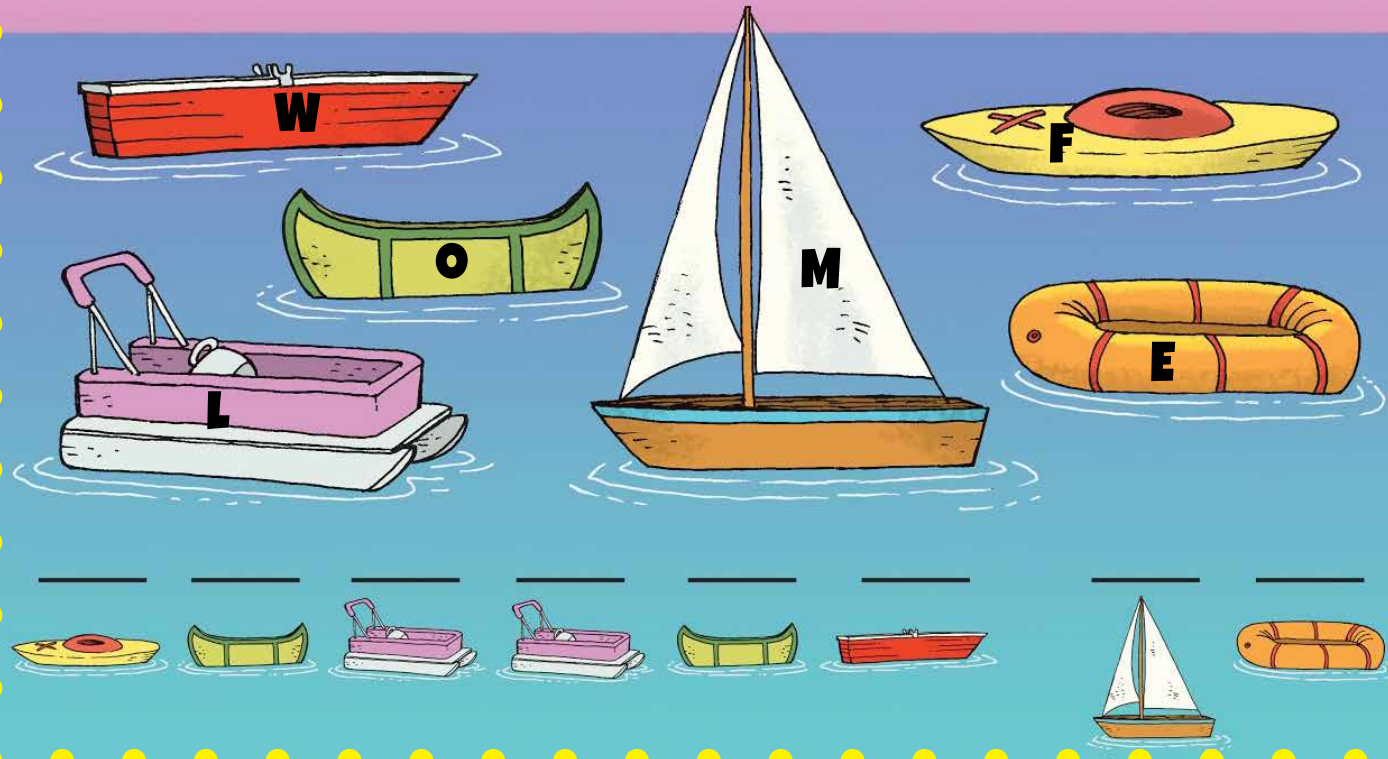
- 4 small sticks
