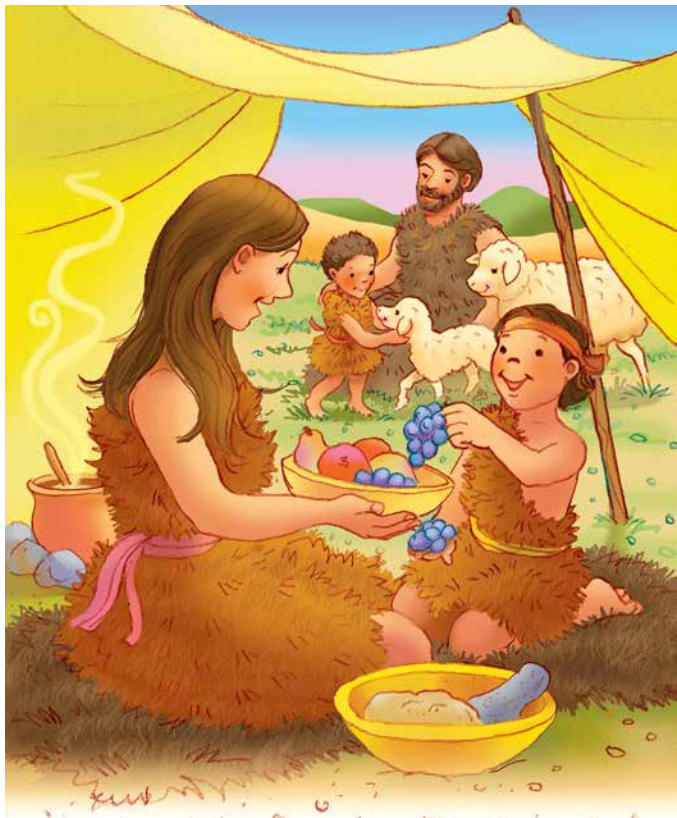

Weeks 1–8: God Created the World
