

You will need:

- 2 clear glasses
- Water
- Salt
- Blue food coloring
- Spoon
- Eyedropper or spoon
- 1. Add 2 cups warm water to each glass.
- 2. Add 4 teaspoons salt to the second glass and stir until dissolved. Then add several drops of blue food coloring to the same

glass and stir until mixed.

3. Using an eyedropper or carefully dripping it from a spoon, add blue salt water to the glass of fresh water. What happens? Why?
