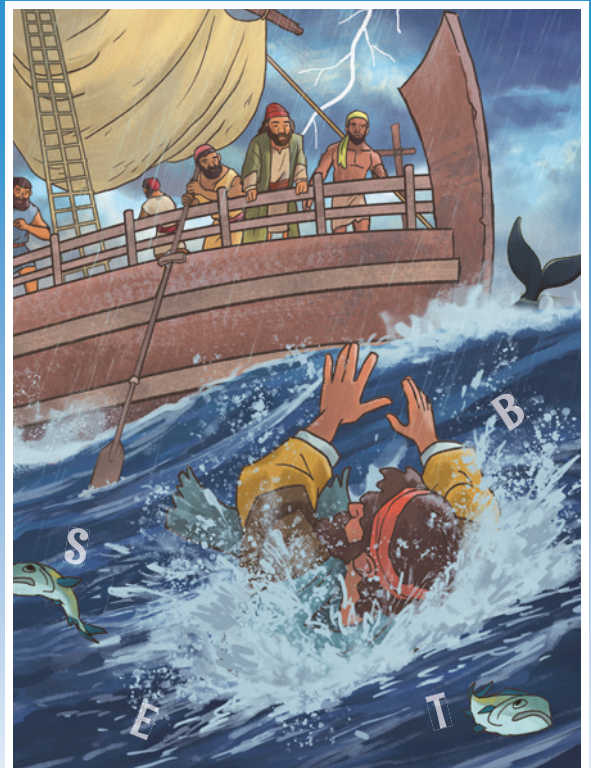

Man Overboard!

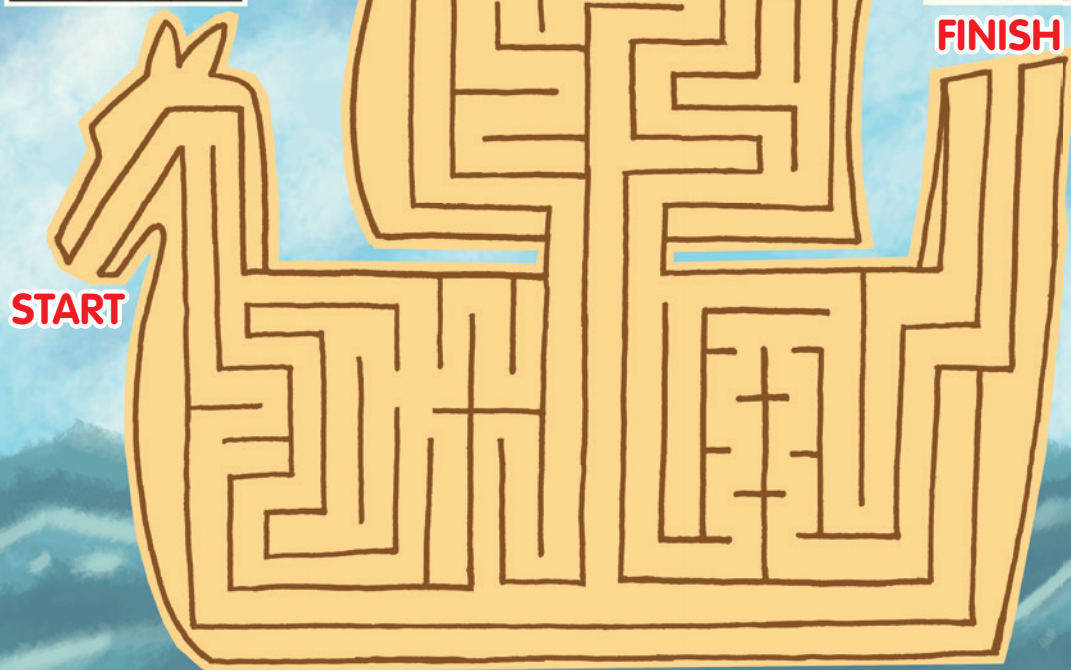

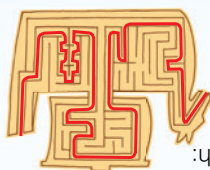

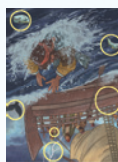
