Notes to the Teacher

- 1. Remove the letter to parents from the front of each student book and sign each letter. Distribute the letter to the parents of each child in your class on or before the first Sunday of the quarter.

Lesson Truths

Weeks 1–8 Peter Served God

For eight weeks we will look at events from the life of Peter, beginning with Jesus choosing Peter to follow Him. We will talk about Peter helping Dorcas and a man who couldn't walk. Other stories feature Peter preaching, Peter's friends praying for him while he was in prison, and Peter writing God's Word. Children will learn that they are not too young to love and serve God.

Weeks 9–13 Paul Served God

The final weeks in this quarter focus on Paul. The Bible lessons include Paul following Jesus, Paul's ministry with young Timothy, and God's care for Paul in a shipwreck and when he was bitten by a snake. We will continue to emphasize that children can love and serve God and that God cares for us.
