Weeks 1–3: God Protected

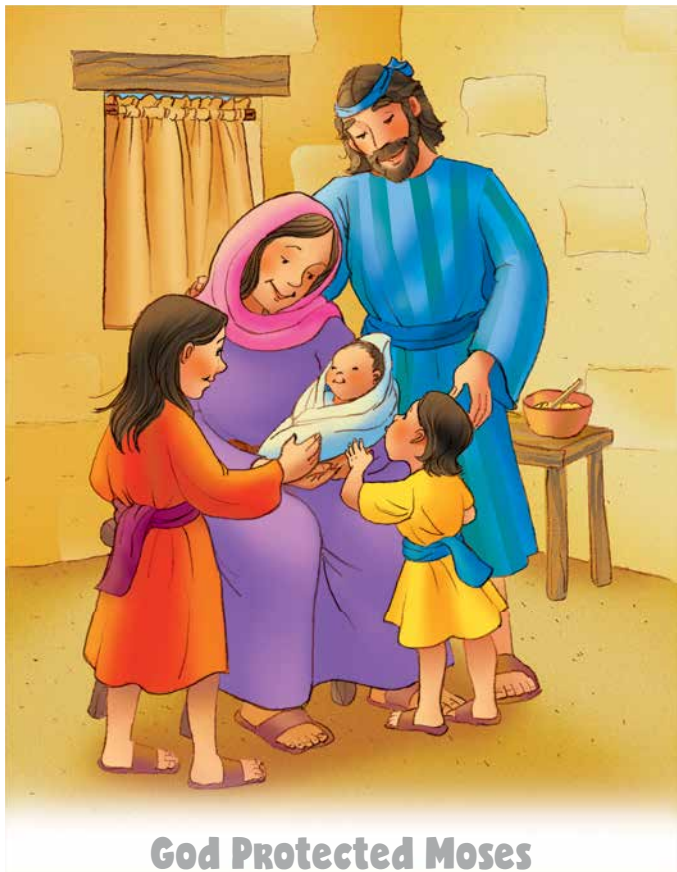
The lessons in this unit focus on Moses: his family, his mother's loving care in making the basket-bed, the princess's care, and grown-up Moses leading God's people. Your child will learn that God cares for us and is with us everywhere.

Weeks 4–8: God Loved

The Bible stories for this unit include Jesus' triumphal entry, His resurrection, two post-resurrection appearances, and His ascension. Your child will realize that Jesus loves us, that Jesus is living, and that Jesus is in Heaven today.

Weeks 9–13: God Cared

This unit includes two Bible stories from the time of Elisha: oil provided for a poor widow and a room made for Elisha. Your child will learn that God gives us what we need, including our homes. In addition, the lessons on Captain Naaman's and a lady's sickness will teach your child that God cares for us and helps us when we're sick.
