

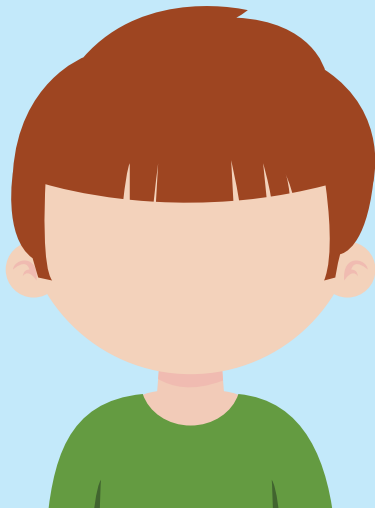
Session 1 Application

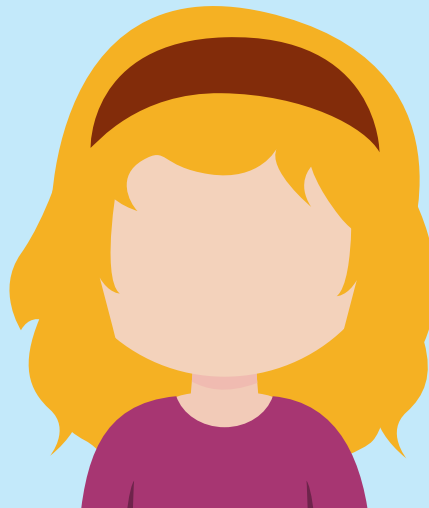


Those who try to find joy by taking from or H others

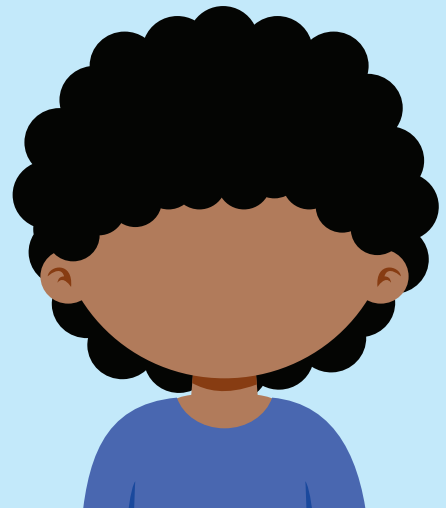

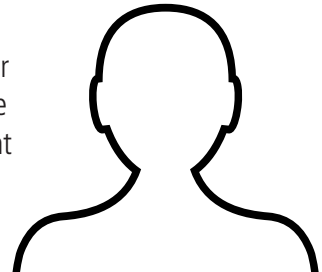
