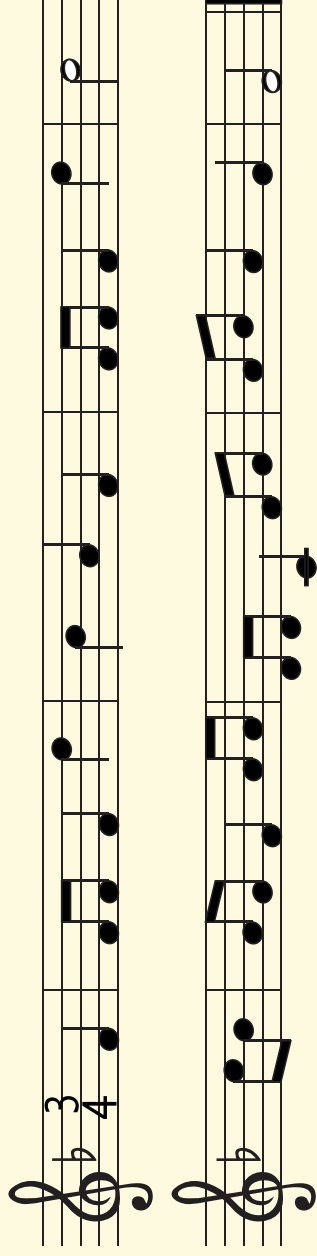

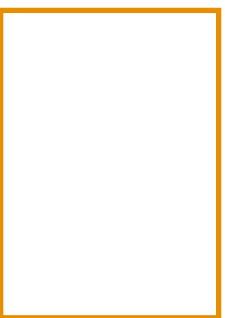
## Praise God Every Day
