### **Weeks 1–5: God Saved Noah**


Through stories about the life of Noah, children will learn what obedience is and that obedience to God, parents, and teachers pleases God. Noah's life pleased God, and Noah obeyed God in all aspects of constructing the boat and putting the animals and food on board.

### **Weeks 6–10: God Provided for Israel**

By hearing about the experiences of God's people, the Israelites, children will learn how God gave His people meat, bread, water, and clothes. Children will realize that God cares for them and meets their needs too.

### **Weeks 11–13: Israel Gave Thanks**

Learning how the Israelites celebrated the Feast of the Tabernacles will help children focus on the theme of thanksgiving. Children will learn the importance of thanking God for everything He has given them.
