
ROCK, PAPER, CRICKET



Cricket is very popular in Australia. It has some similarities to baseball. With a friend, follow the steps below for a cricket match that uses only your hands!

1. Choose who will bat or bowl first.
2. The batsman has the chance to score, and the bowler tries to keep the batsman from scoring. The batsman and bowler play Rock, Paper, Scissors:
 - If the **BATSMAN** wins by **paper**, that person scores one run;
 - if by **scissors**, two runs;
 - if by **rock**, three runs.
 - Ties do not count.
 - If the **BOWLER** wins by **paper**, **scissors**, or **rock**, the batsman's wicket has fallen (that means the batsman is out). After ten outs, the inning is over, and the bowler and batsman switch roles.
3. After four innings, add your points to see who has the higher score. The higher score wins.

True confidence relies on GOD and His Word, so it is God focused. Because God never fails and is all-powerful, we can be confident in Him for life.





- Australia has the longest fence in the world at 3,340 miles long. That's longer than the Great Wall of China! The fence is designed to keep dingoes out of populated areas.


