2s & 3s Lesson Truths

Weeks 1–4: Jesus Was Born

The Christmas unit includes four familiar events from Luke 2: Mary and Joseph traveling to Bethlehem, the birth of Jesus, the angels' appearance to the shepherds, and the shepherds' visit to the manger. Your child will learn that baby Jesus is God's Son and that God planned for Him to be born. Christmas is a special day because it is Jesus' birthday.

Weeks 5–8: Jesus Grew Up

Continuing with stories about Jesus, we will emphasize that Jesus grew. He did not stay a tiny baby. When the wise men saw Him, He was about two years old. When He went to the temple with Mary and Joseph, He was twelve. Your child will learn that Jesus, God's Son, grew, just as your child is growing.

Weeks 9–13: Jesus Helped People

When Jesus performed miracles, He was a grown man. These stories about Jesus will emphasize how He helped people and had power over nature. Your child will learn that Jesus can do wonderful things because He is the Son of God.
