Notes to the Teacher

1. This book has been prepared for primary students. The book is perforated so you can tear out each sheet, complete it in class, and send it home with the student. Each page includes directions for completing the activities on that page.
2. The parent letter is on page 3. Send this page home with the student on the first Sunday of the quarter or deliver it personally before the quarter begins. Page 4 contains an overview of this quarter's lessons, along with a list of all the memory verses.
3. If a student is absent, make sure he or she receives the handwork sheet and the *Strong Kids at Home* take-home paper. This will help the student review the Bible lesson.

Using the Handwork Sheets

The first page of each lesson contains a Lesson Review section. This is an opportunity to review the previous week's lesson. As students arrive to class, let them work on the activity about five minutes into class time. Make sure the students' names are on their papers before you collect them.

You will use the handwork sheets again at the end of the lesson. The students will work on the activities on the back of the sheets. As they work, discuss the Bible story or its application. Let students do as much as time permits, but if they cannot complete the page in class, allow them to take it home and finish it.

An exciting quarter of studies awaits your child in the summer quarter of Primary Sunday School. The book of Acts in the New Testament is action-packed. We will read of the coming of the Holy Spirit, the start of the first church, and exciting accounts of men like Peter, Stephen, Philip, and Paul. Then we will jump to the book of Revelation and discover the wonderful future God has in store for believers.

In units 1 and 2, your child will learn important lessons on serving God and others. Your child will learn that the Holy Spirit helps believers do God's will and serve God well. Importantly, your child will learn the importance of sharing the gospel with everyone, out of obedience to Jesus' command to all His followers.

Unit 3 covers the following future events: the Rapture, Jesus' Second Coming, Jesus' Kingdom on earth, and the eternal home He is preparing for believers. Jesus promised He would return one day. And though we don't know when He will return, we know that God never fails His promises.

Discuss your child's worksheet when he or she brings it home. Set aside time each week to help your child memorize the Bible memory verse, listed on the back of this sheet. Your child will need to recite the current week's verse the following Sunday in class.

Encourage your child to read the *Strong Kids at Home* take-home paper and to complete the fun puzzles and activities. Read through the spiritual growth measurables to engage in your child's learning. Your child will learn a lot about serving this quarter, and we encourage you to find ways to let him or her serve!

Quarter Overview

The Church Begins

Weeks 1—5

Unit 1 begins with the events following Jesus' ascension into Heaven. Students will learn about the Holy Spirit's arrival and His work in the believer's life. Following the accounts of the apostles as they served God, students will know their power to serve God comes from the Holy Spirit.

The Church Spreads

Weeks 6—10

Unit 2 focuses on serving God and sharing the gospel. From the examples of the apostles and the early church, students will understand the importance of faithfully serving God and others with love. Students will also be encouraged to share the gospel in obedience to Jesus' command.

The Church with Jesus

Weeks 11—13

Unit 3 covers the future events of the Rapture, Jesus' Second Coming, the millennial Kingdom, and living with Jesus forever in our eternal home. Students will learn that believers can look forward to the future God has promised us with awe and excitement.

Lesson 13

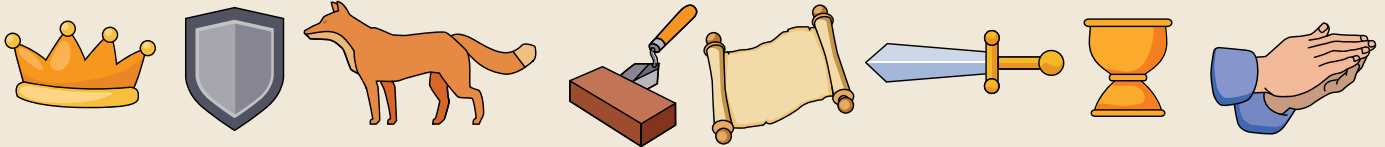
"Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people"
