Snow Globe Repair

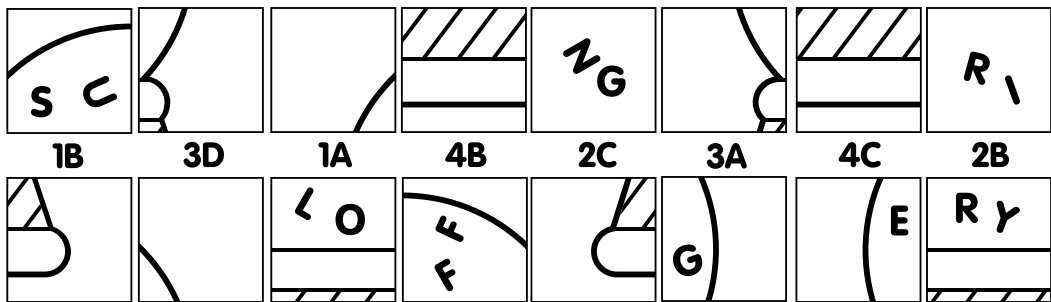

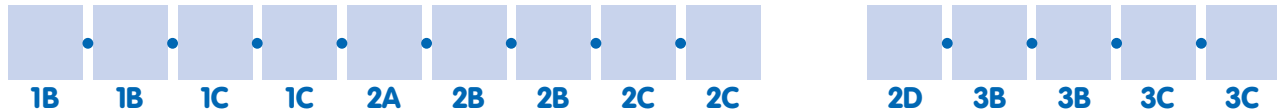
- 1. First, look up and read Romans 8:18.
