Notes to the Teacher

1. This book has been prepared for primary students. The book is perforated so you can tear out each sheet, complete it in class, and send it home with the student. Each page includes directions for completing the activities on that page.
2. Provide the memory verses for the quarter by giving your students a copy of the Memory Verse Booklet available from RBP.
3. The parent letter is on page 3. Send this page home with the student on the first Sunday of the quarter or deliver it personally before the quarter begins. Page 4 contains an overview of this quarter's lessons.
4. If a student is absent, make sure he or she receives a student book sheet and the Strong Kids take-home paper. This will help the student review the Bible lesson.

Using the Student Book Sheets

You will use the student book sheets at the end of the lesson. The students will work on the activities on the front and back of the sheets. As they work, discuss the Bible story or its application. Let students do as much as time permits, but if they cannot complete the activities in class, they can finish the activities at home.

Thank you for bringing your child to Sunday School!

The winter quarter study for primary students presents the theme of salvation. Your child will learn about Jesus, the Savior of all people, and Moses, the man God used to rescue His People from slavery. During the Christmas season we focus on Jesus as a baby. But the Christmas story also introduces us to the fulfillment of God's plan to send a Savior.

The first six lessons make up the first unit. The lessons are about Jesus, His role in creating the world, and God's fulfillment of His promise of a Savior through Him. Your child will learn why Jesus came to earth and why Jesus deserves our worship.

The second unit will teach your child about God's deliverance of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt. God's miraculous work to rescue the Israelites through Moses is a picture of His provision to rescue all people from sin through Jesus. By learning about God's power in delivering and providing for His People, your child will understand that God is trustworthy.

Engage in this quarter by asking your child about the Bible lesson each Sunday. Show interest in your child's worksheet, offer help to complete any unfinished activities, and help your child learn his or her memory verse each week.

Don't forget about the Strong Kids take-home paper your child will bring home each week. Each issue is full of stories, Bible stories, and fun activities. The Growing at Home and Measurables sections in each paper will help you stay engaged with your child's spiritual growth throughout the quarter.

Weeks 1—6

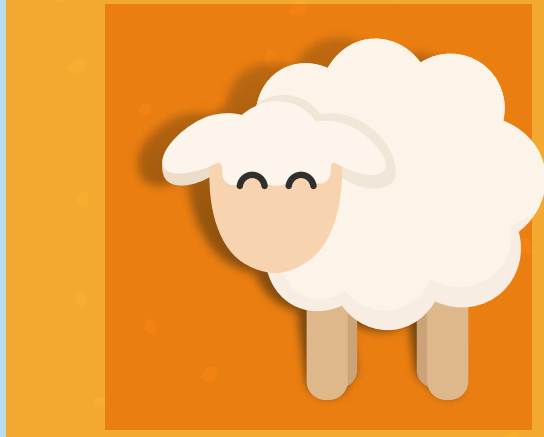
A Savior Is Born

Unit 1 introduces students to God's Son, Jesus, connecting the students' understanding of Jesus' roles both before and after His birth on earth. Lesson 1 tells about Jesus' role as creator and sustainer of the universe. The unit then details the incredible birth of John, who would prepare the people for God's Messiah, and the miraculous birth of God's Son. Jesus' birth was part of God's plan of salvation from the beginning. Students will realize why Jesus is worthy of our worship and devotion.

Weeks 7—13

A Deliverer Is Born

Unit 2 teaches God's work in the life of Moses, preparing him to be used by God to deliver His People from the Egyptians. Weeks 7—13 explain how the Israelites' deliverance from slavery foreshadows God's deliverance of us from our slavery to sin. In both instances, God provides the plan, the deliverer, and the sacrifice. In light of God's great power and love, students will understand that they can trust God and will worship Him for His provision in their lives.
