Unless your child's teacher says otherwise, students need to be ready to say the memory verse from the previous week. So, for example, students work on the memory verse from week 1 during the week following the week 1 date.

Ways to Memorize Verses

You or your child may struggle with how to memorize a verse, especially a longer verse or several verses from a passage. The following are some tips you can use to make the process easier.

1. Put the verse to song. That's how David committed so many truths about God to memory. You can use a familiar tune or make one up.
2. Post your verse where you will see it. The bathroom mirror is a great place. You can review the verse while you get ready for the day in the morning and ready for bed in the evening.
3. Think about what the verse or passage means. Reword it to show that you understand it. Also meditate on how the verse applies to you.
4. Write the first letter of each word in the verse in order and practice saying the verse using just the first letter.
5. Read the verse aloud 10 times, say it from memory 10 times, then write it 10 times. Don't skip the writing part. The exercise will cement the verse in your mind.

Remember that your effort to memorize Bible verses is always worth it!
